'Melissa Dianne Crutchley was born February 20, 1968, in Glen Dale, West Virginia, to Gary Grant and Betty Sue Hartzell Ernest. She died Wednesday, April 5, 2017, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, at the age of 49 years. Melissa completed her secondary education in Breckenridge, Texas, and graduated with the Breckenridge High School Class of 1986. She continued her education through Executive Secretarial School in Dallas, Texas. Melissa was married February 24, 1990, in Breckenridge to Keven Jay Crutchley. She had worked with State Farm Insurance Company and later with First Bank of Owasso, but her primary focus was her family. She was a longtime faithful member of the Anglican Church of St. Paul in Owasso. She was active during her sons' time in the Owasso High School Band and served with the Owasso Band Patrons.
