'Michael John Rogers was born March 24, 1959, in Buffalo, New York to John Rogers Jr. and Margery Anne Hoye. He died Tuesday, November 4, 2014, in Owasso, Oklahoma, at the age of 55 years. Michael was raised in Buffalo until the age of 8 when his family moved to East Brunswick, New Jersey. Michael graduated from East Brunswick High School and went on to Johnson and Wales University, where he graduated with an Associate's Degree in Culinary Arts.
