



## Mildred Alice DeLung

November 13, 1918 - August 10, 2014

' Mildred Alice DeLung, longtime Collinsville resident, passed from this life on Sunday, August 10, 2014, at the age of 95 years. Mildred was born on November 13, 1918, in St. Paul, Arkansas, to Earnest Abraham and Stella Ann (Milligan) Lucas. When she was 13, the family moved to Collinsville, where she graduated high school with the class of 1937. Mildred then attended Oklahoma College for Women in Chickasha, OK, receiving her bachelor's degree in Business in 1941. On June 21, 1957, she was united in marriage to Robert Mark DeLung in Claremore, OK. As well as being a homemaker and mother, Mildred also worked as a bookkeeper. She was a member of the First Baptist Church of Collinsville where she taught Sunday School for over 60 years. Mildred's priority was always her faith and her family, spending many happy times with them especially the grandchildren, great grandchildren and great great grandchildren. She also enjoyed reading, traveling and was a "Tulsa Shock" fan.
