Neta Sue (Williams) Anderson Carrino entered heaven early on the morning of September 24, 2023, surrounded by her family. She was a very beloved wife, mother, grandmother and great-grandmother. 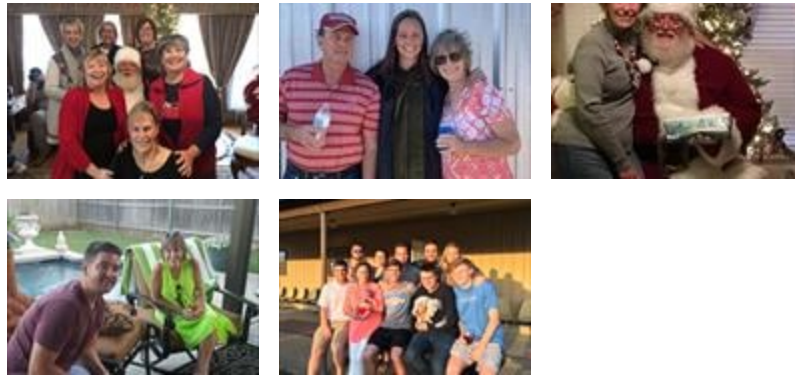
