Norma Dean Logsdon was born June 29, 1931, in Owasso, Oklahoma, to Harold Truman and Verna Marie Eastin Gaylord. She died Sunday, January 17, 2021, in Owasso at the age of 89 years. Norma completed her secondary education in Collinsville, Oklahoma, and graduated with the Collinsville High School Class of 1949 as class Valedictorian.
