Orval "Bud" Tanner, Jr., was born January 13, 1930, in Stroud, Oklahoma, to Nathan and Rena Tanner. He died Thursday, January 23, 2020, in Collinsville, Oklahoma, at the age of 90 years. After completing his high school education, Bud served his country honorably with the United States Air Force during World War II and was awarded the Victory Medal. He then served again during the Korean War and was awarded the National Defense Service Medal and Good Conduct Medal. Bud was married January 18, 1971, in Miami, Oklahoma, to Peggy L. Simpkins. He spent most of his working life as a carpenter including over 26 years with Oklahoma Fixture Company. He was a 32nd Degree Mason with the Masonic Lodge.
