Patricia Dian Zeimet-Jones was born December 6, 1958, in Carmi, Illinois, to Allen Leon Sheraden and Leah Charlene Hodges Sheraden. She died March 22, 2025, in Owasso, Oklahoma, at the age of 66 years, after a courageous battle with cancer. Patti completed her secondary education in Carpentersville, Illinois, where she graduated with the Irving Crown High School Class of 1974. She continued her education at Rogers State University in Claremore, Oklahoma, earning her Associates Degree in nursing. She also completed Firefighter One Training through Oklahoma State University, as well as EMT training through Rogers State University.

Patti worked as a medical assistant and lab and x-ray technician from 1984 to 2001. She worked as a registered nurse from 2001 to 2023. She was a certified hospice and palliative care nurse. Patti served as a volunteer firefighter and EMT with the Verdigris Fire Protection District for 12 years and was also a CPR instructor.

Patti was married May 19, 2016, in Barbados, to Joe Jones. They enjoyed traveling together and taking many trips to Mexico. Spending time working in her garden was also a favorite pastime.
