' Rebecca Ann Corry, resident of Owasso for over 26 years, passed from this life on Wednesday, November 9, 2016 in Tulsa at the age of 72 years. She was born January 7, 1944 at Atlanta, Texas to Walter Woodward and Hollie Bell (Lomas) Cruson.
