' Roger Allen Thompson was born September 8, 1942, in Girard, Kansas, to Oswell David and Mable Mildred Rathbun Thompson. He died Monday, April 3, 2017, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, at the age of 74 years. Roger was reared and educated in Owasso, Oklahoma, and graduated with the Owasso High School Class of 1960 and was an excellent trumpet player. He continued his education attending Southwestern State University in Weatherford, Oklahoma, and received his pharmaceutical degree. He was a veteran of the armed forces having served his country honorably with the United States Army during the Vietnam War. He was married August 24, 1963, in Weatherford to Jacqueline Williams. They made their home in Owasso where Roger began his work as a pharmacist with Soc's Drug Store. After living in Colorado for several years, he and Jacqueline returned to Owasso where Roger purchased and owned the drug store which was known as Owasso Drug. He enjoyed a variety of pastimes including bowling and listening to classical music. He also enjoyed action movies such as the Dirty Harry series with Clint Eastwood and the Death Wish series with Charles Bronson. He will be dearly missed by his family and many friends.
