Ronnie Lee Grimes was born June 27, 1937, in Carthage, Missouri, to Herbert Melvin Grimes and Inas Schell Grimes. He died Monday, June 24, 2024, in Owasso, Oklahoma, at the age of 86. Ronnie graduated from Carthage High School in 1955. He was a veteran of the armed forces having served his country honorably with the United States Navy for six years. Ronnie was married March 9, 1960, in Carthage, MO. to Patsy Anne Butler. They have made their home in Owasso, Oklahoma, since 1965. Ronnie spent most of his professional career in the oil and gas industry as the Manager of Measurement with Oklahoma Natural Gas. He was a man of faith and an active member of the Owasso Church of Christ.
