Roy Gaylen Pugh was born February 26, 1933, in Freedom, Oklahoma, to Leslie Raymond Pugh and Nellie Anna Taylor Pugh. He died Sunday, July 28, 2024, in Owasso, Oklahoma, at the age of 91 years.
