



## Samuel Evan Orr

December 3, 1931 - January 30, 2026

Samuel Evan Orr was born December 3, 1931, in Ash Flat, Arkansas, to Samuel Melvin Orr and Vista Ethel Martin Orr. He died Friday, January 30, 2026, in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, at the age of 94 years. Sam was reared and educated in Owasso, Oklahoma, and graduated with the Owasso High School Class of 1950. He continued his education attending Oklahoma A & M University in Stillwater, Oklahoma. Sam was a veteran of the armed forces having served his country honorably with the United States Army. He was married June 18, 1955, in Sand Springs, Oklahoma, to Patricia Ann Giles, and they were married nearly 64 years.

Sam spent most of his professional working life as an engineer with Rockwell International and Nordam, both located in Tulsa, Oklahoma. He took great pride in contributing to numerous specialized and historic projects such as Saturn V and Apollo rocket boosters. He also worked with the B-1B Bomber and Stealth programs and the design of the Space Shuttle payload bay doors. Sam was a longtime member of the Church of Christ having faithfully served as a deacon with the Valley View (Tulsa), Collinsville, and Owasso congregations. He oversaw new construction projects including building design and preparing blueprints for auditoriums and other facilities for the Collinsville and Owasso congregations. He also took care of building maintenance and upkeep and was actively involved in personal work and outreach programs.

Sam loved his family and his grandchildren were especially dear to him. As a

devoted Christian, he always took moments to teach about God and how we are to live and serve him. He led by example, always making time for others and never saying no when anyone asked for help. A true all-around handyman, Sam could fix just about anything and it was part of his everyday life to use moments to teach us skills and encourage us to think creatively when solving problems. In doing so, he helped us gain confidence and learn how to take care of ourselves and the things that needed attention in life. He enjoyed a variety of pastimes including woodworking, fishing, gardening, and simply being outdoors. These were also hobbies he passed on to all his grandchildren. We always said he loved to just go out and “tinker around” on his land – there was always something to be done and as a hard worker he enjoyed being out there.
