Scott Brandon Thiessen was born on January 5, 1978, in Canyon, Texas to Tim Wayne Thiessen and Mary Rebecka (Jones) Thiessen. He passed from this life on Tuesday, July 2, 2024, at the age of 46 years. Scott was raised and educated in Canyon, Texas and graduated from Canyon High School. He went on to earn his Bachelor of Science degree in Kinesiology from West Texas A&M University and a Master of Education degree from Arkansas Tech University. Scott was married on July 7, 2001, in Canyon to Amanda Jean (Wilson) Thiessen. They have been married for 23 years and together for 25. He started his 20-year career with the Boy Scouts of America at the W.D. Boyce Council and then transferred to the Mississippi Valley Council. Scott then began his role with the Indian Nations Council in 2014, brought in to assist in the development and build-out of the Zink High Adventure Base (ZBase) and its programs. Scott was a proud member of the 14ers, a group that climbs peaks over 14,000 feet. He successfully completed 17 of the 58 Peaks.
