Shelley Lynne Stringer was born March 1, 1964, in Oakville, Ontario, Canada, to Donald Wayne and Sheila Joan (Anderson) Campbell. She died Tuesday, November 20, 2018, in Oologah, Oklahoma, at the age of 54 years. Shelley completed her secondary education in Woodstock, Ontario, Canada and graduated from Woodstock Collegiate Institute in 1984. She continued her education at Oral Roberts University in Tulsa, Oklahoma, where she received her Bachelor of Science degree in Psychology and then earned her Master's degree in Public Health Administration from the University of Oklahoma. Shelley most recently worked as Vice President of Operations with Advanced Hydrocarbon Stratigraphy (AHS) in Tulsa as well as a realtor with Keller Williams in Owasso.

Strong in her faith, Shelley was an active member with Church on the Move in Tulsa, and Harbor Church in Oologah, Oklahoma. She loved helping young people, especially as a leader with the Boy Scouts of America and was instrumental in helping several young people achieve the rank of Eagle Scout.

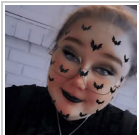
