As you requested, I am sending you a few of our memories of Miss Shirley.

I will always remember how your mom would sit in the central area of our building. If my office door was open, she would wheel herself to the door and kick it shut every time. Sometimes my office mate and I would leave the door slightly ajar on purpose just to see if she would kick it shut. She always did.

The cat. It was such a great idea for you to purchase that cat for her. She would love on that cat. It was very calming for her to hold him and pet him. When she first got the cat, she would take it everywhere with her. It would eat meals with her. She often would feed the cat whatever she was being served that day. Many times the team would have to get the spaghetti noodles off of the cat. When the cat would get too dirty, the cat would go to the veterinarian and spend the night (that meant I would take it home and work it over really good). The first time I took the cat home with me, I had it sitting on my kitchen counter drying out. My son (early 20's) came home and that cat startled him sitting on our counter drying. He was amazed how realistic the cat looked.

Team members knew that the cat was to sit on her bed looking out the window at all times. We loved to send new team members into your mom's room to do something with the bed and let the cat meow or switch its tail and startle the new team member. It was a

source of comfort for your mom and entertainment for team members.

Your mom also enjoyed listening to me play the piano on occasion. She would rarely come into the room where I was playing but chose to stay in the central area where she could still hear the piano. She would tell me how nice I played, smile at me and pat my face in a loving manner.

I loved to get your mom to smile as her smiles were very rare. But she did have a great smile when I could coax one out of her. The love she had for your father and her kids was evident.
