Shirley anonymously delivered boxes of food and clothing to their homes in the dark of night, never seeking credit to avoid embarrassing her students or their parents.

Shirley was ecstatic when her daughters were married and ultimately ten grandchildren and five great-grandchildren came into her and Tom's lives. She adored being a Nana, and fervently loved all her grandkids and great-grandkids. We celebrated many birthday parties, holiday get-togethers, weddings and anniversaries with our parents, Shirley and Tom.

We are confident that Shirley is with her Maker in heaven, and was welcomed by Jesus saying, "Well done, my good and faithful servant". This confidence we have in Christ was imparted to us as children by our parents. We are eternally grateful for the way she lived her life for Christ. What a precious gift and legacy she leaves for all who knew and loved her.
