Timothy Anthony Baltz was born Jun 6, 1951, in Pocahontas, Arkansas, to George Henry and Margaret Frances Dust Baltz. He died Thursday, September 16, 2021, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, at the age of 70 years. Tim completed his secondary education in St. Paul, Arkansas, and graduated with the St. Paul High School Class of 1969. He was a member of the Boy Scouts of America and achieved the level of Eagle Scout. He continued his education at the University of Arkansas where he earned his Associates Degree. Tim began his working career in radio and television broadcasting. He served as warden for the Arkansas Department of Corrections and Corrections Corporation of America. He was an inspector with Creative Corrections. Most recently he worked as a loss prevention officer with Macy's.
