Verna attended 8 years of grade school in a one room country school and was taught by the same teacher, Mrs. Tomanek, all 8 years. That is a beginning in consistency and simplicity which has given Verna a foundation of strength and family to build her life on. Upon graduation from Trego Community High School, she then continued her education at Brown Mackie School of Business. Her first job was a statistical typist.
