Vernon Walter Lewis was born May 8, 1928, in Howe, Oklahoma, to Walter Vernon Lewis and Cordia Pearl McCauley. He died Sunday, August 4, 2024, in Bartlesville, Oklahoma, at the age of 96 years. Vernon completed his secondary education in Howe, Oklahoma, and was a graduate of Howe High School. He continued his education attending Carl Albert State College in Poteau, Oklahoma.

Vernon spent most of his professional career as the owner and operator of Vernon Lewis Lumber Company in Collinsville, Oklahoma. He was a strong man of faith and was an active member of Owasso First Assembly of God. He served as a deacon, taught Sunday School, and was involved with nearly every committee or board within the church. He also served many years as a board member with the Verdigris Valley Electric Cooperative in Collinsville. Vernon enjoyed a variety of pastimes, especially woodworking.
