Walter Don Kerr was born February 26, 1936, in Owasso, Oklahoma, to Earl Irvin and Esther Pauline Shue Kerr. He died Friday, January 15, 2021, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, at the age of 84 years. Don went to Owasso Public Schools from 1st thru 12th grades and graduated with the Owasso High School Class of 1954. He continued his education at Connors State College in Warner, Oklahoma, where he played football for the Cowboys. He was married November 28, 1959, at the Nazarene Church in Collinsville, Oklahoma, to Shirlene Gaylord. Don was a veteran of the armed forces having served his country honorably as a Ranger with the United States Army. He also served on the Presidential Honor Guard at Arlington National Cemetery. He spent most of his working life in sales marketing with Yellow Freight Systems and Transcon Lines. Don was a faithful member of First Church in Owasso, formerly First Christian Church. He was a member of the Owasso Masonic Lodge #545. He enjoyed a wide variety of outdoor sports including fishing and hunting. He also played softball in several men's softball leagues over the years.
