Warren Lavell Norris was born on February 7, 1941, in Pineville, Louisiana to Leon Landry Norris and Ettie (Scarborough) Norris. He passed from this life on Sunday, December 17, 2023, in Tulsa, Oklahoma at the age of 82 years. Warren was raised and educated in Leesville, Louisiana and graduated with the Leesville High School Class of 1960.
