William Alex (Bill) Boklach was born July 11, 1938, in Scranton, Pennsylvania. He passed into eternity on Thursday, January 9, 2025, in Owasso, Oklahoma, at the age of 86 years. Bill joined the United States Air Force in 1956 and was honorably discharged as a Korean War veteran in 1962. While serving in the Air Force, Bill was awarded the Good Conduct Medal along with a longevity award.
