William James King was born March 25, 1947, in Queens, New York, to William Burdick King and Frances Lee Walsh. He died Tuesday, August 18, 2020, in Green Bay, Wisconsin, at the age of 73 years. Jim completed his secondary education in Melville, New York, and graduated with the Half Hollow Hills High School Class of 1965. He attended Southwestern University in Chula Vista, California, where he earned his associate's degree as an electronics technician. He later attended Tulsa Junior College in Tulsa, Oklahoma, earning an associate's degree in electrical engineering. Jim was a veteran of the armed forces having served his country honorably with the United States Navy and the United States Coast Guard for over 21 years. He proudly served as a Vietnam Veteran. 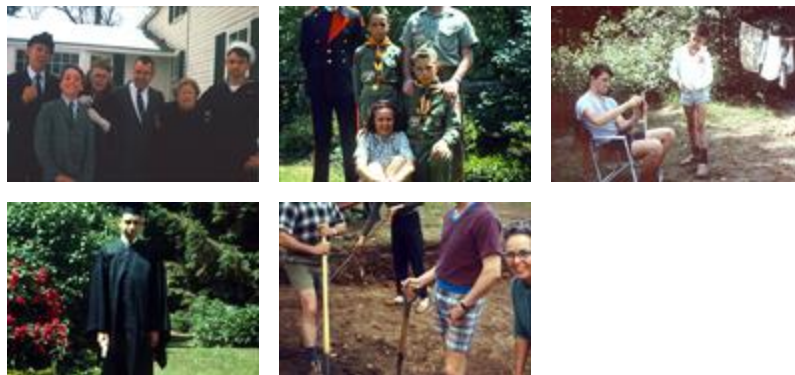

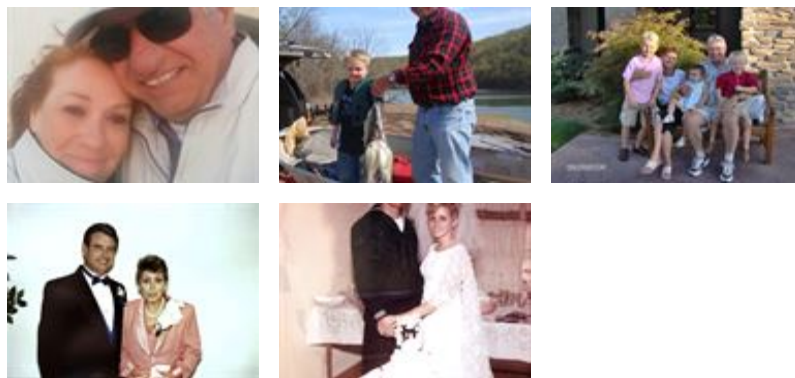

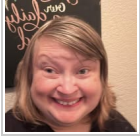
