William Patrick "Pat" Talbot was born March 17, 1967, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, to Billy Howard and Sharon Ann Friend Talbot. He died Saturday, August 3, 2019, in Owasso, Oklahoma, at the age of 52 after a courageous battle with ALS, or Lou Gehrig's disease. Pat completed his secondary education in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, and graduated with the Broken Arrow High School Class of 1985. He continued his education at Oklahoma State University in Stillwater, Oklahoma, where he earned his bachelor's degree in business management. Pat was married December 2, 1995, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, to Michelle Loveless. He began his working career with Southwestern Bell before joining Cisco Systems in Tulsa as a business development manager. He was a faithful active member of Rejoice Church in Owasso. Pat enjoyed a variety of pastimes, including a passion for soccer. He was also an accomplished guitarist, playing in the church band. 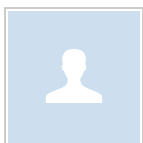
