' Willis Blair Austin, longtime resident of Collinsville, passed from this life on Wednesday, September 24, 2014 at the age of 92 years. Willis was born October 13, 1921 at Sageeyah, OK to Henry and Xenia (Blair) Austin. He was raised and received his education in the Oologah area.
